Policy Statement

Central Louisiana Technical Community College recognizes the importance of academic honors to acknowledge student accomplishments. Following are the academic honors and their requirements:

Dean's List:

The Dean's List is a means of encouraging and recognizing academic excellence. To be eligible for this recognition, a student must achieve a minimum of a 3.50-grade point average for a semester while enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours. Students receiving a grade of Fail "F" or an Incomplete "I" for the current semester are ineligible for this recognition.

Chancellor's List:

To be eligible for this recognition, a student must achieve a 4.00 grade point average for a semester while enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours. Students receiving an Incomplete grade "I" for the current semester are ineligible for this recognition.

Graduating students may also be recognized with symbols of academic accomplishments. All courses that fulfill graduation requirements, including courses from other accredited institutions, will be used to calculate the grade point average for honors designations. Students who have earned an associate degree diploma, career and technical certificate, or certificate of technical studies and maintained a cumulative grade-point average of 3.00 or above will receive honors recognition in the commencement program as noted below:

Honor Designations:

- Chancellor Honor Graduates: 3.80 - 4.00
- Magna Cum Laude Graduates: 3.50 - 3.79
- Cum Laude Graduates: 3.30 - 3.49
- Honor Graduates: 3.00 - 3.29
